

Important Notice to Swansea Mews Tenants



COURT ORDER TO VACATE

On June 27, 2022, the City of Toronto applied to the Ontario Superior Court of Justice for a Judgment to confirm and enforce the Emergency Order dated June 12, 2022 issued by the Chief Building Official of the City of Toronto which immediately prohibited the use and occupancy of all townhome units in Swansea Mews.

On July 4, 2022, the court confirmed the Chief Building Official's order that tenants must vacate Swansea Mews immediately, as continuing to occupy units at Swansea Mews carries a risk to personal safety. A copy of the court's judgment is attached to this notice.

Tenants who continue to occupy units at Swansea Mews are advised to take whatever steps they require to vacate their units immediately.

If you do not leave your unit by the end of the day on July 6, 2022, the court has authorized the Sheriff of Toronto to help the City and the Chief Building Official evacuate Swansea Mews.

TCHC continues to be prepared and willing to provide all tenants still living in Swansea Mews with temporary accommodations, financial and other supports while a long-term relocation process is completed. All Swansea Mews tenants have the right to return to the community when it is safe to do so.
